

Affirmation of Faith

Lord, make us the community of St Michael's into instruments of your peace. Where there is hatred, let us sow love. Where there is injury, pardon. Where there is doubt, faith. Where there is despair, hope. Where there is darkness, light. Where there is sadness, joy. May we not so much seek to be consoled as to console, not so much to be understood as to understand, not so much to be loved as to love. For it is in giving that we receive, it is in pardoning that we are pardoned, and it is in dying that we awake to eternal life.

Lord, kindle the flame of your love in our hearts; in your mercy, hear our prayer.

We pray for those who suffer:

Lord Jesus Christ, in the Garden of Gethsemane you shared with everyone who has ever been afraid. You conquered fear with love and returned saying 'Do not be afraid'. In the light of your love, death has lost its sting, and so has fear. May your love be the key that releases us from suffering and fear.

Lord, kindle the flame of your love in our hearts; in your mercy, hear our prayer.

For he communion of saints:

Lord, give us grace to follow in the footsteps of the saints, as they followed in the footsteps of your holy Son. Keep alive in us the memory of those dear to ourselves whom you have called to yourself; and grant that every remembrance which turns our hearts from things seen to things unseen may lead us always upwards to you, until we come to our eternal rest.

Lord, kindle the flame of your love in our hearts; in your mercy, hear our prayer.

Bless the gifts we bring, and bless our lives so that our discipleship will also be marked by generosity of heart and hands that witnesses to your love, through Jesus Christ's our Lord. Amen.
